



The name commemorates the former ownership by the Convent of St Ursula in Beaune but it has been owned by the Jadot family since 1826. The wines are silky-smooth and elegant with great suppleness. Louis Jadot regard this as their flagship wine: with justification.

Bibi Graetz Testamatta Rosso

Tuscany, Italy

Rich and textured, displaying flavours of ripe berries, black cherries and sweet spices

Bibi Graetz is one of Tuscany's great mavericks and for nearly two decades has been concentrating on making some of the most distinctive and exciting wines in the region. After the initial Supertuscan revolution in the 60s and 70s with Sassicaia and Tignanello, Bibi leads another wave of pioneers. Specialising in old vine Sangiovese, his vineyards, dotted about Chianti Classico, are populated by gnarled fifty-eighty year old vines, which provide great intensity and wisdom to his wines. The diverse blend of terroirs, and soil types further add to the kaleidoscope of complex characters his wines exude. Very attractive combination of dried fruit and spices with black cherries and plums. Aromas of flowers and sandalwood, too. Full-bodied and very refined, yet intense, with plush, velvety tannins that are wonderfully integrated and intertwined with the fruit. Ripe center palate.

The vines lie on an ancient historical site, thought to have once been part of a sprawling Roman estate, and later a leper colony - its name comes from the french word 'Gaffet,' meaning leper.

Francois Millet Volney 1er Cru 181

Burgundy, France

Finely wooded with bright red fruits and floral, violet aromas. The 'triangle', Francois loves the elegance offered by this 1er Cru. East exposition, lots of Limestone near the surface. Complex, elegant, powerful and structured with an awe-inspiring purity of place. Make no mistake, this is one of the worlds great Pinot Noir for those in the know.

Château Beychevelle 2014 212

Bordeaux, France

Elegant and powerful, expressing aromas of red fruit, blackcurrants and spices. Château Beychevelle Saint-Julien is a Fourth classified growth. It already reveals power and a beautiful structure that turns into creamy tannins. On the palate, one discovers roundness, persistence and enjoyable characteristics - due to the fine grapes of Cabernet Sauvignon - which foreshadow a perfectly balanced wine. This is a promising 2014 Beychevelle, one among the best.

Château Montrose 1998 297

Bordeaux, France

Silky and fresh on the palate, with notes of tobacco, dark chocolate, coffee, dark fruit and leather. The 1998 vintage from Chateau Montrose demonstrates a splendid maturity reached by this noble St-Estephe wine. This particular year's offering stands as a testament to the resilience and adaptability of the Chateau in a season that posed substantial challenges across Bordeaux. Complex on the nose, delivering aromas of leather, black fruit, liquorice. Silky and fresh on the palate, with notes of brown tobacco, dark chocolate, grounds of coffee, blackberry, blackcurrant, and slight leather. The tannins are fine, elegant, and melted.

Château La Mission Haut-Brion, Cru Classé Pessac-Léognan 2011 393

Bordeaux, France

An enticingly aromatic nose of ripe red berried fruit, baked earth with subtle menthol and cedar notes. Comprising 62% Merlot and 38% Cabernet Sauvignon there is a sweetness of red berries and blackcurrants on the entry before the finely tuned tannins envelope the palate with waves of textural richness building towards a fan tail finish with notes of leather and sweet spice.

With enticing aromatics of ripe blackberry, graphite and an earthy nose, there is a restrained exoticism here typical of the finest Oakville Cabernets. The palate is plush with incredible quality of sweet tannin and great balance, making it very approachable, like a Pauillac on steroids. With black cherry, iodine, camphor and real vitality, this is a wine of many layers with a very bright future.

Château Lafite-Rothschild, 1er Cru Pauillac 2006

Bordeaux, France

Still something of an unsung hero. The 2006 Lafite-Rothschild was one of those classically proportioned vintages from this Château; it exuded refinement but was possibly outgunned by richer, bolder more powerful examples when tasted prior to its en primeur release in spring 2007. If the prerequisites for a great wine are harmony, refinement, purity, proportion and length of flavour with sufficient structure to reward long-term ageing, then 2006 Chateau Lafite-Rothschild is surely one. A classic in the truest meaning of the word. Opaque in the glass, Lafite shows beautiful scents of blackcurrant, tobacco leaf and minerals. The palate is bold and expansive, with a taut tannic structure that is veiled by appealing pure, dusky black fruit. A classical, majestic Lafite with fine potential. Robert Parker Score: 97 points
